### Safety for Survivors of Domestic Violence



### Abused Woman Finds Safety Through Legal Aid

Susan was terrified. The previous night, she was awakened by her husband punching her in the stomach. This wasn't the first time Susan was abused, but it was certainly the worst. Susan was kicked, pushed down a flight of stairs, pulled by her hair and thrown into a wall. Thankfully Susan managed to escape and get to a hospital to treat her severe wounds.

Susan turned to Legal Aid Society of Salt Lake for help. She feared not only for her own safety, but for the safety of her two children. Legal Aid staff helped Susan obtain an ex parte protective order that day and helped her access other services needed to care for herself and her children. A Legal Aid attorney represented her at the trial where she obtained a permanent protective order.

Susan and her two children are finally free from abuse and safe in their home.

## Access to Education



## Student Thrives With Individual Education Plan

Brian is a student with Autism. Despite repeated attempts, Brian's mother was unable to obtain an evaluation for special education services for her son. The Disability Law Center advocated for the client at the initial Individualized Education Program meeting, where it was determined that the student did qualify for services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), and that additional evaluation would be completed.

The school district still failed to complete the evaluations and design an Individual Education Plan for the student within IDEA guidelines.

The Disability Law Center filed a state complaint which articulated several areas of non-compliance. The school district denied all of the allegations, so the Disability Law Center appealed to the Utah State Office of Education. The final decision was favorable to Brian on all issues. The decision called for a plan of correction, monetary reimbursement for evaluation costs, and completion of an Individual Education Plan within 30 days.

## Disability Income

Brian, who has a low IQ, was unable to work. He applied for Social Security Disability Income but was denied. A common occurrence for individuals seeking this benefit.

Brian turned to Utah Legal Services to appeal his case. The case was appealed unsuccessfully through the administrative process, so Utah Legal Services appealed the case to the US District Court. The Court remanded the case and a new Administrative Law Judge was assigned to the case. The new Administrative Law Judge agreed that Brian was disabled and eligible for Social Security Disability Income. Brian was awarded six years of retroactive disability payments.

## Two Children Protected From Abusive Mother

Paula is a mother of two children. Paula was drinking one evening when she apparently got upset; so upset that she lifted the table and turned it over with food spilling all over the floor, according to her daughter. She picked up a knife and went after the two girls, one 10 years of age and the other 15. The girls ran out of the house. There were eyewitness accounts from people driving by who had seen Paula with a knife in her hand and chasing the girls. Both girls were crying and hollering.

A state police officer was called; Paula was arrested and the two children were taken into DCFS custody. The girls revealed that this was not the first time their mother had threatened them. They talked about how in another instance, she had thrown fire logs at them, barely missing them. She made them walk home on another occasion (at least 6 miles in the snow when she forced them out of the car); one of the girls said she did not have a coat at the time. Utah Legal Services advocates assisted in successfully filing a protective order against the mother until she is able to get treatment. The matter was then left to the court to make a determination on returning the children.

The mission of “AND JUSTICE FOR ALL” is to increase access to civil legal services for the disadvantaged and for individuals with disabilities in Utah by:

Creating and sustaining resources to support civil legal services,

Sharing and consolidating resources so that services are delivered in a cost-efficient and effective manner, and

Strengthening the member agencies and the distinct roles they play in the delivery of civil legal assistance.

## Justice In Action

### Disability Law Center

The Disability Law Center (DLC) is designated by the governor to protect the civil and human rights of people with disabilities in Utah. It is part of the federally mandated Protection and Advocacy system, and serves as the state's primary legal advocacy agency for Utahns with physical, mental and developmental disabilities.

### Legal Aid Society of Salt Lake

Legal Aid Society of Salt Lake provides legal representation for low-income individuals in family law cases and for those needing protective orders in the Third District Courts in Salt Lake County. Legal Aid's domestic violence program assists adults and children who are the victims of domestic violence regardless of the victim's income.

### Utah Legal Services

Utah Legal Services (ULS) provides legal advice and representation in civil cases to low-income Utahns statewide. ULS helps individuals maintain safe housing, solve family conflicts, and preserve income and health care benefits. The agency also assists seniors, Native Americans and migrant farm workers with a variety of legal problems.

### 2009-2010 Grantee Organizations

"AND JUSTICE FOR ALL" awards grants to additional agencies that ensure all citizens receive access to the legal system. In December 2009, grants were awarded to the following civil legal aid programs:
